# RULES & REGULATIONS | | | | | | | | | |

- Players must reach the gaming centre within 5 mins of a race announcement, otherwise the particular player is subject to automatic disqualification
- Players are given 3mins to setup their own controls (if they bring) like keyboard, mouse, joystick or joypads with USB2.0 connectivity only. Players are not allowed to use STEERING WHEELS.





- · Collision detection will be turned OFF.
- Performance will be turned ON.
- Cheating/use of trainers will result in disqualification.
- Minimizing/Exiting during a race will result in immediate disqualification.
- Players are not allowed to use their own SAVEGAME files and modded cars.
- No headphones will be provided.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

There will be a 4 way Sprint race. One who will be the winner will get the prize.

#### **RACE MODE**

First and foremost rule, it is the player who gets to choose his transmission mode.

#### Rules:

- N2O should be off, There should be no Speed breaker.
- Player has to complete his 2 laps given, to get his time jotted down.
- Car to be used is BMW M3GTR, with single computer opponent at EASY level.
