GENERAL RULES:

- This is an <u>individual event</u>. Participation in team is not allowed.
- Each participant can register as many times as they want. It is an hourly event.
- > The decision of event coordinator will be the final one in regards to all the issues pertaining to the event.
- > Rules are subject to be changed due to unavoidable circumstances without prior information and surely participants will be informed about all changes before beginning of event.
- > Use of any unfair tricks will lead the very participant towards disqualification.

RULES FOR EVENT:

- ➤ There will be two rounds in the event. Participants qualified in first round will be allowed to compete in second round.
- First round will be pen and paper based case solving round where participants will be given mystery and/or codes to be resolved within that given hour.
- Additional clues may be provided but it will cost penalties.
- ➤ Participants reaching the correct conclusion in the shortest time will be selected for second round.

➤ <u>In second round</u>, that is the final round will <u>comprise of a crime scene</u>. Qualified participants have to deal with clues observing the crime scene to come to the conclusion. Lastly they have to analyse their conclusion.
